We would like to inform students and families that, as part of the “**Non uno di meno**” project within the National Recovery and Resilience Plan aimed at combating early school dropout, our school will be organizing lessons to enhance the digital literacy of both students and their families. The goal of this initiative is to support users in effectively utilizing digital platforms, apps, and tools provided by the Italian Public Administration, with a particular focus on those used in Italian schools to improve communication and interaction between users and platforms.

For this purpose, students and families are invited to enroll in a free 10-hour course. The course is designed to teach the proper use of the *Registro Elettronico* (the digital school register software used in our school) and to improve familiarity with the tools used by Italian Government Offices.

Each course consists of four sessions, each lasting 2.5 hours. Classes will be held in classrooms equipped with computers and Internet access.

The schedule of the lessons is as follows:

1. Thursday, October 3rd, from 3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.
2. Tuesday, October 8th, from 3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.
3. Thursday, October 10th, from 3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.
4. Tuesday, October 15th, from 3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.
